From next week, we will not be sending out paper copies of Blue Print so please make sure you catch up with all the latest Blue Coat news through your email every Friday!

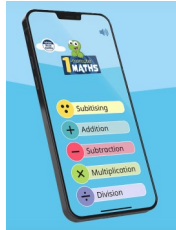
1 - MINUTE MATHS

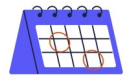
It is not too late for your child to bring in any written work for the writing challenge or certificates from the library for us to celebrate in school. Please send these in by Thursday next week.
